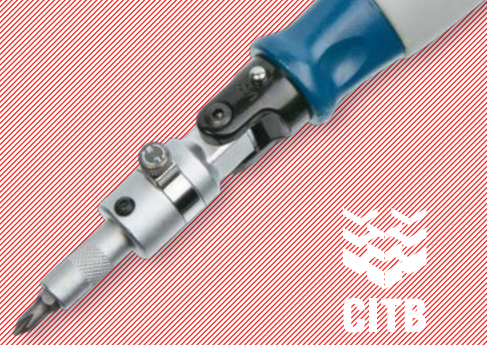


DOORWAYS 2 CONSTRUCTION



OVERVIEW

Endorsed by the Construction Industry Training Board, the D2C program is South Australia's premier Vocational Education and Training (VET) in schools program for the building and construction industry.

Employers can select apprentice candidates from a pool of work-ready, partial-Cert III qualified students from the doorways2construction™ (D2C) program. Students come into the workplace with White Card, PPE gear, on-job experience and a good work ethic.

In their senior years, students engage in construction training with an RTO whilst continuing to complete their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE). This affords employers the opportunity to look at a School Based Apprenticeship as a possible employment tool. The program is run in 56 schools across the state with student participation from Years 10-12. D2C industry pathway programs include general construction, plumbing and civil and provide a broad and general introduction to the industry.
