


SHORT COURSE FUNDING



OVERVIEW

The construction industry is constantly changing with employees and companies always trying to keep up with the latest technologies, regulations, standard updates and licensing requirements. Not only is there a legal requirement to meet these, there is more often than not a competitive advantage for both companies and employees knowing about them and addressing them. Upskilling or cross-skilling yourself and your workforce to meet these changes is one of the main reasons the fund was set up by the South Australian Building and Construction Industry in 1993.

The CITB provides funding for over 300 short courses to holders of the CITB Training Card to make training more affordable and more accessible to the South Australian Building and Construction Industry. Training is provided by CITB approved Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) throughout the State both in Metropolitan Adelaide and Regional South Australia and Funding takes the form of a discount to the retail price of a training course. If you have a valid CITB Training Card you can up-skill/cross-skill at a discounted rate.

COURSE RATES

The discounts vary considerably, depending on the complexity of the training, course hours and whether plant, materials, training rooms etc. are required. Samples of discounts available include:

*The retail price is variable depending on the RTO.

HOW TO ACCESS SHORT COURSES

Speak to a CITB Field Officer on 8172 9500, they can advise you on funded courses at a location convenient to you, or visit citb.org.au and click Find a Course.

When you have selected your course provide the RTO with your valid CITB Training Card

number, book in a date and organise payment. Depending on the course and the RTO you may have to pay up front and be reimbursed upon successful completion of the course, or you will be charged the discounted rate at the time of booking. The RTO will handle your queries regarding payment of the course.
