



APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING SUPPORT (ATS)

CITB provides ATS funding, employers must be approved and registered with CITB.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To claim CITB funding, employers must be registered and approved with CITB.

Employers must ensure their apprentices/trainees have an approved CITB number linked to their organisation to be eligible for CITB funding.

To obtain a CITB number, apprentices/trainees must:

- have an approved training contract (TC) with Traineeship & Apprenticeship Services (TAS)
- be undertaking a eligible qualification
- be employed by a eligible employer

FUNDING COMPLIANCE

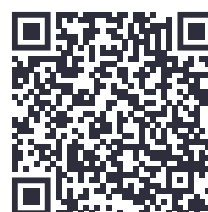
Employers must:

- comply with the obligations described in the training contract and supporting training plan
- ensure the apprentice/trainee is employed and has an approved Training Contract at the time of claiming the CITB funding
- agree to pay the RTO directly for all off-site and associated trade training and assessment costs for the eligible apprentices/trainees supported by the CITB payment
- acknowledge that CITB will seek to recover any payment made that is not compliant with funding criteria

HIRING THROUGH GTO?

Did you know that if you are hiring an apprentice or trainee through a CITB Endorsed Group Training Organisation our funding is passed on to you through a reduced hourly rate or in a lump sum payment (depending on the type of funding)?
